
What is the Adelaide Gig City Program?

- Deliver affordable Gigabit speed data and internet service to specific innovation precincts
- Drive economic development opportunities and job creation for South Australia
- Adelaide will collaborate with other Gig Cities around the world
- Partnership between SA Gov't and SA Broadband Research and Education Network (SABRENet)
- SABRENet network will supply Layer 1 dark fibre circuits to precincts
- Layer 2 and Layer 3 services to be contracted through public tender
- Funding of \$4.7 million over four years (2016-17 to 2019-20)
- Stage 1 14 existing innovation precincts to be connected by 30 June 2017
- Stage 2 future innovation precincts (e.g. old RAH) to be connected in 2017-18

What is SABRENet?

- The South Australian Broadband Research and Education Network (SABRENet)
- Not-for-profit company jointly owned by SA Government, Flinders University, University of Adelaide & the University of South Australia
- Network established in 2006 and currently has connections to over 160 sites
- Provides fibre connections for universities, TAFE colleges, teaching hospitals, schools, AARNet, DSTG, CSIRO & research precincts
- Several precincts are already connected by SABRENet fibre
- New fibre connections will be needed for other precincts


