Why The survey


- The survey is part of the thesis towards a M.Sc that I was working on.

 - Not part of this presentation, but feel free to talk to me later.





2. What does the Cloud mean for you?





3. Which of these companies do you associate with the Cloud?





4. Have you ever read, heard about any of the following standards related to cloud computing? Select all that you know of.




What's confusing about the cloud

5. What's the most confusing aspect of the cloud paradigm and needs clarity?




Cloud Connectivity existence

6. Do you know about dedicated cloud connectivity options?




Internet vs. Cloud Connection vs. Hybrid




Difficulty in Cloud Connection

8. What is the most difficult part of connecting to the cloud?




Do you use the cloud ?

9. Do you have any cloud services (eg. Mail, Storage, applications, etc) in use?




First Impressions

Some Thoughts

- The data itself speaks in most cases.

 - Most users still do not differentiate cloud connectivity from the cloud

Some Gaps

- I wonder if the geography of respondents had anything skew.
 - I think my social media contacts are likely APAC biased
- I didn't think the governance issues would be so prominent in responses. Didn't have any follow-up questions on it.
- Enterprise users didn't seem to distinguish that 'user-cloud' like social media are a different segment then the enterprise cloud services.
